The current structure and functioning of the IRS in the Czech Republic is an important aspect of population protection. Given the absence of such a system in Nigeria, it was therefore a logical choice. Even in this case, it can be stated, Due to the above-standard duration of the study, however, the processing of the work lacks continuity and systematicity. The theoretical part of the work is limited only to the analysis of legal, normative and institutional understanding and definition of the

issue. There is no more detailed analysis of other countries, at least the EU. However, in spite of the fact, its satisfactory extent can be stated. In the practical part of the work, the selected type activity of the IRS CR was applied to the conditions in Nigeria. Due to the absence of such a comprehensive and functioning system, it is therefore possible to assume the practical benefits of the work. Despite a significant number of formal shortcomings that have been remedied at the last minute, the work meets both the formal and content requirements for this type of work. I therefore recommend the work for defense.
