


Inceptor Ing. Zuzana Oplatková appraisal

Inceptor MSc. Zuzana Oplatková has been working on her topic since 2003. During her activities at FAI she shows not only extraordinary interest in research activity itself but also in pedagogical activities at FAI and universities abroad. She was an author or co-author of 2 journal papers (1 is in review process), 19 conference papers (included GECCO or astronautical congress in Japan which was fully supported by ESA) and also a co-author of several chapters in an upcoming monograph “Evolutionary techniques – principles and applications” in Czech edition.

She also works at universities in Finland, Poland and Italy. Furthermore she presented 4 invited lectures abroad. In Czech Republic she presented a popular-scientific lecture “Astronautic congress Fukuoka 2005 – With an ant to Fukuoka” (Planetárium Praha).

Not only above mentioned lectures but also a fact, that inceptor is a member of international organizing board of conferences ECMS 2007 and ECMS 2008 (Prague and Cyprus) and track chair there as well can be considered in appreciation of research community. Her paper was awarded as best paper at ECMS 2007.
